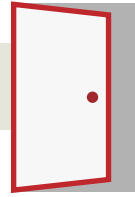

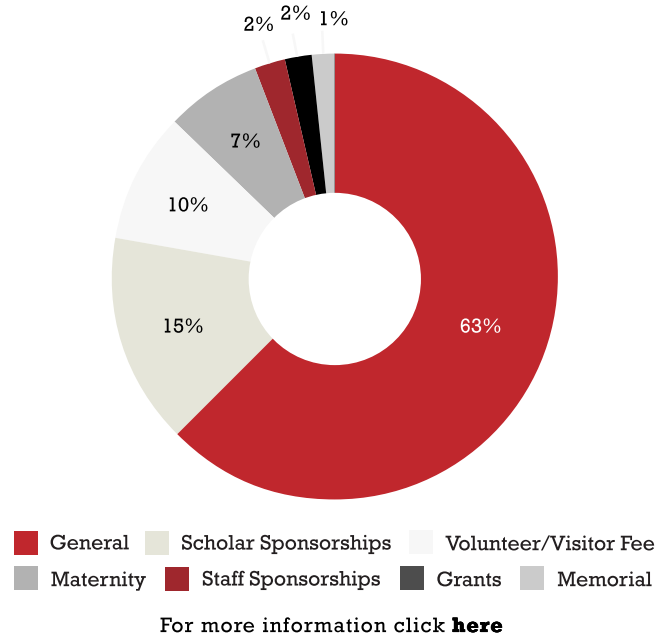

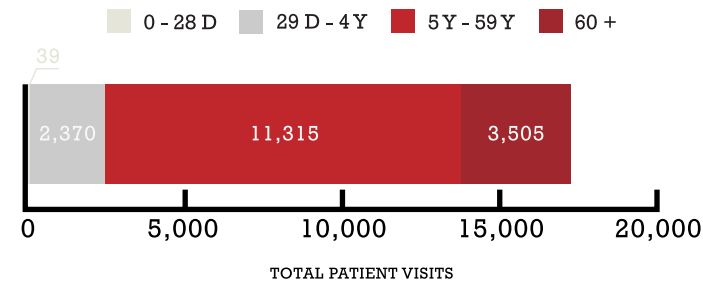

AGE OF PATIENTS TREATED



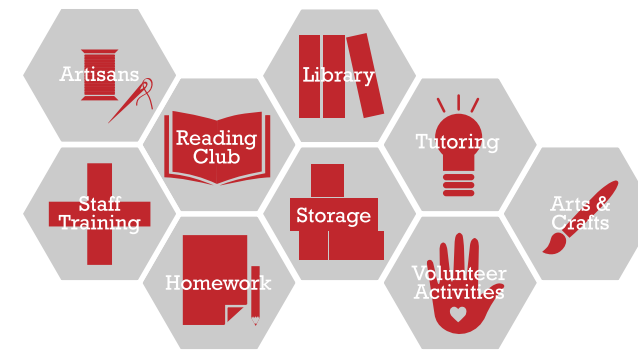

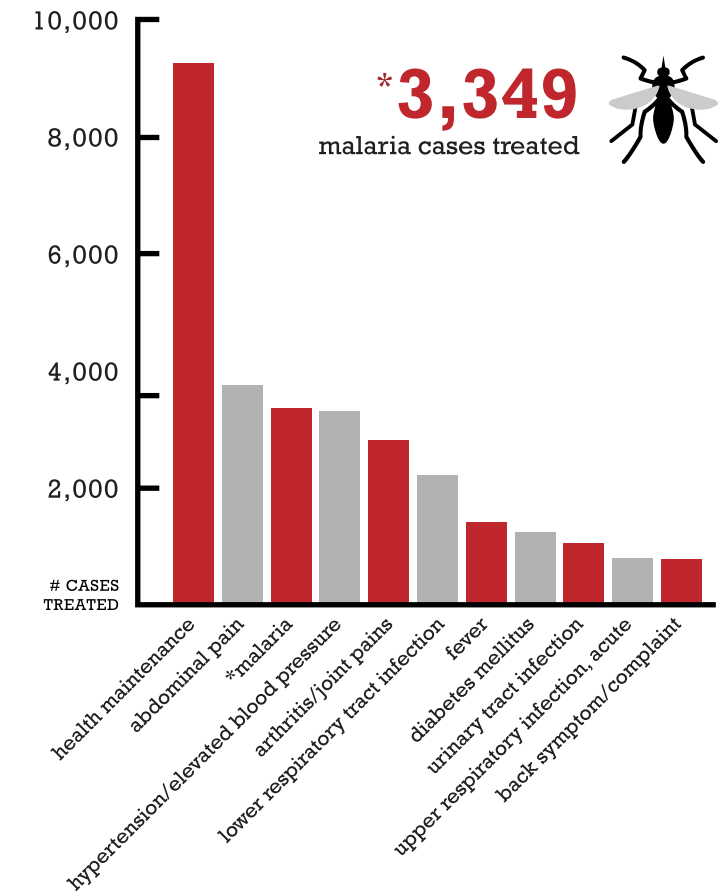
NUMBER OF ENGEYE SCHOLARS

THE MOONCATCHER PROJECT

Engeye partnered with **The MoonCatcher Project** to provide women and girls with reusable pads.

22 local females are trained by Engeye volunteers to sew washable and reusable menstrual pads to ensure their lives are uninterrupted by their cycle.

Over **100** kits have been distributed to females in the surrounding community. Additionally, classes on menstruation management and reproductive health are offered to school girls entering puberty.
